# Callahoe's Benicio :\$ 1,980 Cdn/dose

Please note: no member discount can be offered on Benicio doses



After his licensing, Benicio was taken to South Africa. Two years later, however, having been convinced by the high quality of his foals and his extraordinary potential for advanced level dressage, Benicio returned him to Germany to be professionally trained by Anna-Sofie Fiebelkorn for sport and to earn his full breeding approval for the Hanoverian Studbook.

The rest is History. This remarkable partnership elevated Benicio out of nowhere to win the 2011 German Bundeschampionate for the six year old dressage horses and the Stallion Performance Test at Schliekau with perfect 10's for walk, trot and canter. His final score for the dressage section, 9.88, superseded even that of his father and is the highest score ever achieved in the history of the stallion performance test. With these scores, combined with his faultless rideability and character, this incomparable stallion has captivated the European dressage and breeding community.

# Brentano II : \$495 Cdn/Dose



Brentano II was awarded the prestigious honour of Hanoverian stallion of the year 2003, awarded to stallions with a tremendous influence on the breed. He descends from one of the most important mare families in Hanover, going back to the Schumann-daughter S449. The stallions Garibaldi I and II, Wolkenstein I and II and Beltain as well as Beauvalais, one of the internationally most successful dressage horses with Beatriz Ferrer-Salat, all belong to this equine family. After having won his stallion licensing, Brentano II moved to the Celle National Stud. At his stallion performance test, he presented the best dressage performance, and with a final score of 129,97 points, he ranked second. One year later, he achieved the fourth place at the Bundeschampionate of Riding Horses. He was trained up to advanced dressage level, and he often took part in the Celle Quadrilles. The chestnut stallion is the sire of 68 state premium mares and 15 licensed stallions. Brentano II is a dressage stallion with an exemplary inheritance, and his dressage breeding evaluation reaches the above-average mark of 137 points. With his successful offspring, he is one of the sons of the trademark stallion Bolero who ensured a revival of this bloodline in sport.

His three fantastic gaits and constant willingness to perform were rewarded with outstanding marks. In Vechta, Buckingham's incredible disposition also delighted the test riders, earning him a 9.5 for rideability.

This performance is of no surprise, as Buckingham's father Bordeaux was placed 4th at the World Championships of Young Dressage Horses with Eva Möller. The dam's sire Rousseau, also came second in the Dressage Championships in 2003.

Diacontinus went on to qualify for the 2015 National Championships in Warendorf and again in 2016! Diacontinus' sire, Diarado, is currently one of the most popular jumping horse producers. Due to the French blood of his sire, Diamant de Semilly, Diarado created new opportunities for the German show jumper breeding, and he has delivered show jumpers of the very best quality.

#### Don Frederico : \$990 Cdn/Dose



The elegant and impressive Don Frederico became Champion of his 1999 Hanoverian Stallion Licensing. This "eye-catcher" completed his stallion performance test as runner-up with the amazing score of 151.67 points in the dressage section. He also constantly improved his qualities during the test, proving his excellent mental qualities. Don Frederico showed excellent rideability and very good basic gaits; sure to impress all dressage riders. His offspring are already well proven in sport. In 2005, Dantonisius and Dark Carlotta were Champion and Reserve Champion Four Year Old Riding horses (mares and geldings) at the Bundeschampionate. Several offspring are successful at the International level, including the successful Grand Prix gelding, Don Johnson (M.S. Warkant) ridden by Isabell Werth, who won many top CDNs and CDIs including the Grand Prix Special at the 2012 CHIO Aachen and the 2012 Vienna Masters CDI4\* Grand Prix. And also the mare, Diva Royal, and Dorothee Schneider who participated in the Olympic Games and impressed everyone with a final Kur score of 81.661 placing 7th in the world. Don Frederico was rated by the German Equestrian Federation as the second most valuable sport horse breeding stallion of 2005, based on his Breeding Value Index of 174 points, with an assurance of 89% heritability. In 2012 he was awarded Hanoverian Stallion of the year, a title awarded to stallions with an exceptional influence on the breed.

#### Don Index: \$825 Cdn/Dose



Don Index, the Champion of the 2010 Stallion Performance Test in Adelheidsdorf, is a model example of performance potential. This noble, ground covering, young stallion presented himself from the beginning of his performance test as a true winning type. Always endowed with the right attitude, he is convincing with his intelligence and eagerness to work. These elements are what enabled the black stallion to win both the performance test dressage and overall indexes, and the title of Premium Stallion. From his sire, Don Crusador, who was successful up to S Level himself, you find the lovely refinement of Lauries Crusador xx, which is responsible for the noble and beautiful type of Don Index. Success is also prominent through Don Index's damline, as he stems from the line of Jahde from the year 1885. Many successful advanced S Level horses have come out of this line, including the most well known representative in international sport of Weyden, who, under Sven Rothenberger, was the 1996 Olympic silver medalist and the number one ranked dressage horse in the world on the 1996 WBFSH dressage list. Don Index's own foal crops have contained some excellent foals; He produced the both of the top selling foals of the 38th Hanoverian Elite Foal Auction; "Da Capo" and "Djordy" who were sold for 26,000 and 22,000 Euro respectively.

#### Escudo I: \$660 Cdn/Dose



Escudo I has been one of the best German stallions on the breed value rankings for years. His FN breed value in the 2016 Hanoverian Stallion book is 145 for jumping, and 86 for dressage. Escudo I was awarded the prestigious title of 2009 Hanoverian Stallion of the Year. He was the winner of his stallion performance test in 1994 and achieved a convincing 144.90 points in the jumping category. He is a son of the Celle State stallion Espri, who is known worldwide for producing outstanding jumping horses. Escudo I exhibited phenomenal jumping talent himself, winning the 1996 Hanoverian Show Jumping Championships in Dobrok in 1996, and the six-year-old Jumper Champion title in 1997. He was also the winner of several show jumping competitions at "S" level in 1999. Escudo I is outstanding in type and expression, is well-muscled and has excellent gaits. In the 2017 Hanoverian Stallion book, he is credited with siring 723 competitive horses (124 in S class) with winnings totalling more than 3,100,243 euros. He has sired 18 horses with individual winnings of more than 15,000 euros – including the likes of Embassy II who with Hans Dieter Dreher is the winner of 1,021,673 euros in prize money, Enorm who won 376,208 euros with Ludger Beerbaum, Escobar with Thomas Weinberg has won 145,166 euros and El Paso (Jessica Kuerten, Markus Beerbaum) who was the Bundeschampion of five-year-old show jumping horses in 2003 and has gone on to win 38,038 euros.

Belissimo produced nine stallion performance test winners from just his first few foal crops, as well as countless well known high-performance horses. Beautiful conformation and equipped with elastic, powerful movement, Fusionist delighted the German State Stud and the expert audience at his licensing in 2020. Fusionist presented himself with a very confident canter and an outstanding trot at his sports test in Verden, including scores of 9.5 for trot and a 9.0 for rideability and overall impression. The score for his canter was also impressive at 8.7 and he received an 8.2 for his rhythmic walk. With a final score of 8.88, Fusionist was winner amongst the four-year-old stallions. He comes from a performance-oriented, originating with the mare Aslaug. His dam Evita has already produced three licensed stallions and five state premium mares. His sire Franklin is very popular throughout Europe and the US. Dressage and show jumping horses at an international level adorn the portfolio of this line including; the 2013 world champion of young dressage horses, Scara Boa, from the Pape stable, the former Celle state stud stallion Wandervogel I and II, Wandervogel III, who was successful up to Inter I, and Wandervogel IV was also a part of the dynasty and competed up to the Grand Prix under Heiner Schiergen.

#### Londonderry: \$825 Cdn/Dose



Londonderry was named Hanoverian Stallion of the Year 2013, a title awarded only to stallions with an exemplary effect on the breed. His sire, the famous Lauries Crudasor XX, was also stallion of the Year in 2006. He always impressed with his extraordinary, expressive movements and his flawless exterior. Londonderry was the overall winner of his stallion licensing in 1997. One year later he was fifth at the stallion performance test, achieving 134.56 points in the dressage category. In 1999 he convincingly won the riding horse performance test during the German Riding Championships in Verden. The quality of his descendants under the saddle has no equal as well.
